Thank you for your letter of August 15th, in which you look back on our partnership so far and give a preview of all the projects we could tackle together in the new association year.

First of all, I would like to wholeheartedly underline your assessment: since we both got to know each other through the mediation of your Foundation Ambassador Daniela Hausdorf, we have become a good team in an incredibly short time. Neither the Covid-19 pandemic nor other unpleasant challenges have been able to dissuade us. What we as an association - and I personally most of all - appreciate so much is your smart, friendly and principled approach to any kind of task. During the construction phase of the new girls' house, your foresighted planning and experienced construction management brought the project to a good conclusion in a very short time.

Also, we as an association can only positively highlight how much we appreciate the tirelessness with which you fight for the girls entrusted to your care - and this in addition to your clinic work and despite the serious illness that struck you in early 2020.

Dear Fatou, I would like to emphasize in particular that we have always found the handling of monetary donations to your foundation to be pleasantly transparent and trustworthy. We know that you and your staff always keep in mind that these donations are made here in Germany wholeheartedly by many not so rich people. You let us participate at any time with your many photos, information and videos in the conversion of the money donations into results, be it medicines, garbage cans or treatment appointments. Likewise, your photographic reports of the handing over of the donations in kind are always a great joy for us and an incentive to continue to work together with you on the expansion of the clinic and the preservation of the girls' house.

From our side, we can confirm the projects you have outlined for the period starting October 2020:

- Expansion of the clinic and laboratory for better medical care for patients, especially pregnant and breastfeeding women.
- adequate medical care for girls with special needs, especially Isatou Tamedou (heart disease) and Awa Tamedou (spinal injuries)
- Furnishing of the new girls' house
- Support for the upkeep of the girls' home: food, school fees
